Guidelines for Library Display Case Exhibits

1. Materials and content are selected for exhibit in the library display cases based on their current or historical significance, and relevance to local community needs and interests.
2. The library reserves the right not to display items or content deemed to be of only limited interest to the community as a whole.
3. No materials or content will be excluded on the basis of race, national origin, ethnicity, religion, gender or gender identity, or political or social views of the contributor.
4. Materials or content will not be excluded solely because the frankness of presentation might be offensive to some viewers or readers. However, the library will not display material which is obscene or defamatory, or which disparages individuals or groups on the basis of race, national origin, ethnicity, religion, disability, or gender or gender identity.
5. The library reserves the right to choose in which display case items will be exhibited.
